

Cape Air Virtual >> Charter Routes



>> *Flying new aircraft into new destinations!*

>> Cape Air Virtual is pleased to announce the addition of event charter routes! This will allow pilots to fly any aircraft during BVA events.

>> Events include Regional Circuits, Domestic Journeys, General Aviation Fly-Ins, Pack the Patterns, Getaways, and Hyper Tension Conventions.

>> Routes will be entered into VAFS as LearJet (LR4) Charter Routes (CH).

>> The charter route flight numbers will be in the KAP9xxx range and can be filtered by clicking "View All Routes" and "Apply Filter". When all routes are displayed, click the "Type" field on top and it will bring Charter Routes to the top of the display. You may also find these routes by entering the starting or ending airports in "Search Routes" form.

>> When selecting the aircraft callsign, do not use KAPxxx. Instead, fly with a November callsign, regardless of the aircraft. For example, N501TW.

>> During Getaway events, pilots will be able to fly charter routes from Boston (KBOS) to the featured airport of the Getaway prior to the event. After the Getaway, pilots can depart the main Getaway airport and head back to Boston (KBOS). However, these flights may only be flown during off-peak hours when there is no ATC online.

>> Flying charter routes is only allowed during BVA events; you may not fly non-CAV aircraft for Scheduled Passenger (SP) routes.

>> VAFS does not check the loaded aircraft for these routes, so you can fly any aircraft of your choice!
